









Organized by the IAOHIN Gallery, and sponsored by the Sofitel at Ponte 16 Macau, this exhibition features huge roots from the Indonesian rainforests, divided in two exhibition halls. French sculptor Mickaël Obrénovitch spent years of effort to reveal the profound connection between humans and nature. He chose ancient roots that have over 200 years' history from Java Island, Indonesia. He thinks that roots are the witness of a faded colony and they represent the helplessness of nature for eternity. By abstract art, he tries to express the relationship between humans and nature to call for mankind's gratitude for nature.
