



## 'HUMAN ROOTS' EXHIBITION OF SCULPTURES COMES TO UMA BY COMO, UBUD



Uma by COMO, Ubud—our luxury central Bali hotel—will be transformed from July 18th to October 18th as open spaces filled with wooden sculptures by artist Mickaël Obrénovitch. The selling exhibition 'Human Roots' kicks off with a three-course charity dinner at Uma Ubud's Italian restaurant Uma Cucina featuring specialities such as goats cheese-stuffed blossoms and roasted seabass, with 25 per cent of ticket sales going towards the local 'Give a Gift That Grows' project.

French-born artist Obrénovitch uses 200-year-old teak wood from Java for his work, influenced by the notion of the Indonesian forest as Asia's lung. With the natural world as the theme, the work will be on show in Uma Ubud's COMO Shambhala Retreat wellness sanctuary, the pool bar, lobby and Italian-inspired restaurant Uma Cucina. Other pieces will be exhibited at sister property COMO Shambhala Estate, in the lobby, tea house and Ojas lounge.
